crescendo - gradually louder

decrescendo - gradually quieter

a note that is held for four beats

Week 6: Musical Alphabet A - G

collection of letter names assigned to notes on the musical staff

Week 7: Tempo

the speed at which a passage of music is or should be played

Week 8: Review Week

Week 9: Dotted Half Note

a note that is held for three beats

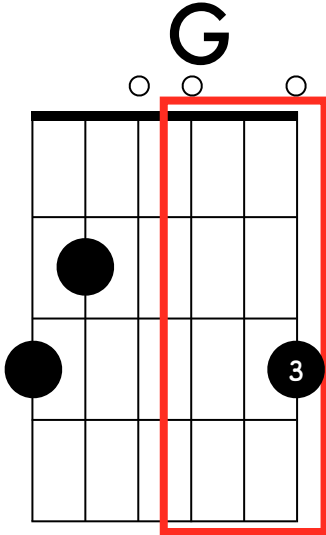
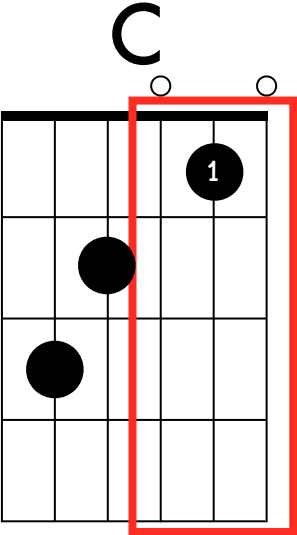
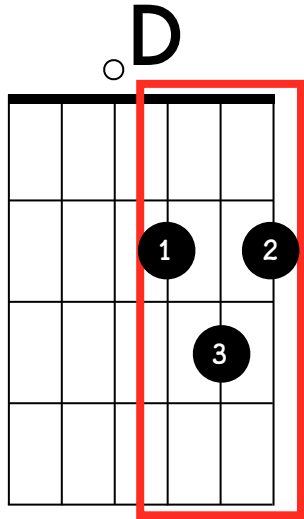
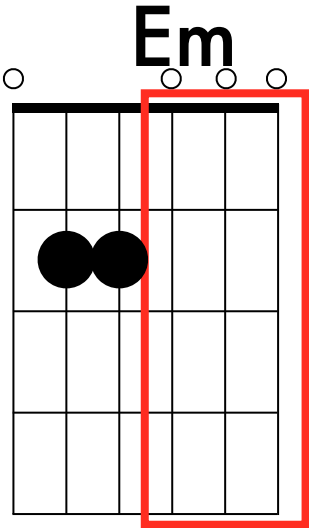
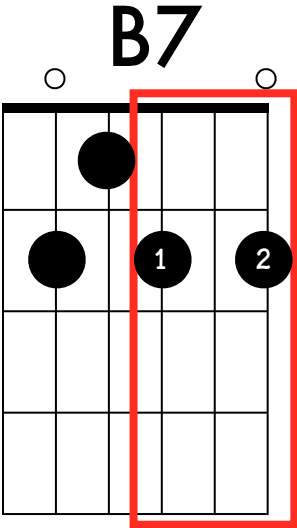
